SAVOY BROWN HEADLINES DELAWARE RIVER BLUESFEST SEPTEMBER 4

The fourth annual **Delaware River Bluesfest**, this year featuring **Savoy Brown with Kim Simmonds**, returns to the Stockton Inn on Saturday, September 4.

Savoy Brown, formed in London by Kim Simmonds, was one of the first British blues bands to record in 1966. They have performed in such legendary venues as Carnegie Hall, Fillmore East and West, and recorded a live album in New York's Central Park. They have performed on the same bill as Led Zeppelin, Janis Joplin, Rod Stewart, Jethro Tull, Fleetwood Mac and Eric Clapton. Three of the original members of Foghat got their start with Savoy Brown.

Also performing is **David Sancious & Jim Weider Blues Project**. David Sancious was one of the original members of Bruce Springsteen's E Street Band. Performing on keyboard and guitar, and as composer and producer, he has recorded and toured with such notables as Peter Gabriel, Eric Clapton and Jeff Beck. No stranger to the Stockton Inn, Jim Weider received acclaim for his long tenure as lead guitarist with The Band.

Noted blues guitarist **Kal David** will also appear. Kal joined with Paul Colton to form Illinois Speed Press. He later moved to Woodstock, NY, where he formed The Fabulous Rhinestones. He is now performing and touring with partner Ms. Lauri Bono.

Rounding out the program are local favorites– Lehigh Valley’s Don Mayer Band, Lambertville’s J. B. Kline Band, and Trenton’s Joe Zook & Paul Plumeri and T. J. Nix/ Paul Plumeri Blues in Disguise.

A portion of the proceeds will benefit NOVA (Network of Victim Assistance) of Bucks County and SAFE in Hunterdon. Both organizations provide free confidential services to victims of domestic and sexual abuse and offer community education and prevention programs.

Delaware River Bluesfest is the third and final concert produced by Falcon Productions in celebration of the Stockton Inn’s 300th anniversary. The concert begins at 1:00 p.m. with doors at 12:30 p.m. Food and beverages are available for purchase throughout the day and evening.
